## NOTES

**Note:** The figures given above have been extracted by Bedfordshire Archives Staff from standard sources. Whilst no responsibility can be accepted for errors or omissions, Bedfordshire Archives will ensure that corrections notified to them are included in future issues of this leaflet.

### Notes to the figures

1811 census – exclusive of 94 militiamen who could not be assigned to their respective parishes

1821 census – exclusive of 336 militiamen who could not be assigned to their respective parishes

Rural Districts – these are the rural districts as they existed between 1891 and 1974

Bedford Rural District – the former Eaton Socon Rural District was absorbed into Bedford R.D. in 1934

Eaton Bray Rural District – this district was abolished in 1933 and its area transferred, with Toddington (originally in Ampthill R.D.), to Luton R.D.

Eaton Socon Rural District – the former Eaton Socon Rural District was absorbed into Bedford R.D. in 1934

Districts – these are the four districts established in 1974

Unitaries – these are the three authorities established in 2009

ASPLEY GUISE – part of parish taken to form the new parish of Aspley Heath in 1883

ASPLEY HEATH – parish created in 1883 from Aspley Guise, and enlarged in 1885 by part of the parish of Wavendon (Bucks)

ASTWICK – population figures for Astwick included with Stotfold from 1991. The 1991 population is estimated at 30

BARFORD, Little – population figures for 1991 are included in Roxton, and from 2011 with Wyboston, Chawston & Colesden

BATTLESDEN – population figures for 1991 are included with Milton Bryan

BIDDENHAM – part of Biddenham became part of Bedford in 1933; part of Biddenham became Great Denham in 2007

BILLINGTON – part of Billington was transferred to Leighton-Linslade in 2003, thereby halving the population

BLUNHAM – see also Moggerhanger, for which separate figures have been recorded since 1801

BOLNHURST – combined figures for Bolnhurst and Keysoe given from 1951

BRICKHILL – parish created in 2007 from Bedford

BROGBOROUGH – separate figures from 1991, covering an area (formerly included in Husborne Crawley and Ridgmont) which became a separate parish in 1989

CADDINGTON (Herts.) – mainly transferred to Bedfordshire in 1897

CADDINGTON – Parts of Caddington became part of Luton in 1933

CADDINGTON – figure given for 1901 is 1515 (sic), but this does not tally with the combined totals for the Beds, and Herts. parts – 1053 + 1017 = 2070

CAMPTON – figures also includes Chicksands from 1991

CARDINGTON – see also Eastcotts, for which separate figures are given from 1801. Part of Cardington was transferred to Bedford in 1933

CHALGRAVE – part of Chalgrave was transferred to Hockliffe in 1929

CHALTON – parish created from Toddington in 2000  
CHELLINGTON – figures for Carlton and Chellington given together from 1951  
CHICKSANDS – figures included with Campton from 1991  
CLAPHAM – part of Clapham was transferred to Bedford in 1933  
DEAN – figures for Dean and Shelton given together from 1951  
DENHAM, GREAT – parish created from Biddenham in 2007  
DUNSTABLE – became a municipal borough in 1864. Part of Houghton Regis transferred to Dunstable in 1907  
DUNTON – figures include Edworth from 1991  
EASTCOTTS – part of Eastcotts was transferred to Bedford in 1933  
EATON SOCON – partly transferred to Huntingdonshire in 1965, becoming part of Cambridgeshire in 1974. The remaining part of the parish, named Staploe, remained in Bedfordshire. The population figures for Staploe are 1971 [349], 1981 [328] and 1991 [333]  
EDWORTH – figures included with Dunton from 1991  
EGGINGTON – including some 300 houses brought into Eggington by a 1970s boundary change but transferred back to Leighton-Linslade in 1985  
ELSTOW – part of Elstow was transferred to Bedford in 1933  
FARNDISH – population for Farndish included with Podington from 1891  
FLITTON – see also Silsoe, for which separate population figures are given from 1801. The figures for Flitton include Greenfield – explicitly from 1991  
GOLDINGTON – the parish of Goldington became part of Bedford in 1933  
GRAVENHURST – the parishes of Upper and Lower Gravenhurst were amalgamated in 1888  
HATLEY, COCKAYNE – the population figures are included with Wrestlingworth from 1991  
HEATH & REACH – part of parish transferred to Leighton Buzzard U.D.C. in 1933  
HIGHAM GOBION – figures included with Shillington from 1991  
HOCKLIFFE – part of Chalgrave was transferred to Hockliffe in 1929  
HOLWELL – parish transferred to Hertfordshire in 1897  
HOUGHTON REGIS – part of parish transferred to Dunstable in 1907 and part to Luton Borough in 1939  
HULCOTE – parish amalgamated with Salford in 1933  
HUSBORNE CRAWLEY – figures exclude Brogborough from 1991  
HYDE – formerly a hamlet in Luton. It became a separate parish in 1895  
KEMPSTON – the town became an urban district in 1895, the outlying areas of the parish being thereafter designated as Kempston Rural  
KENS WORTH (Herts.) – transferred to Bedfordshire in 1897  
KEYSOE – joined with Bolnhurst c.1934, and combined population figures given for Bolnhurst and Keysoe from 1951  
KNOTTING – joined with Souldrop c.1934, and combined population figures given for Knotting and Souldrop from 1951  
LEAGRAVE – formerly a hamlet in Luton. Became a parish in 1895, but wholly transferred to Luton Borough in 1928  
LEIGHTON BUZZARD – the township became an Urban District in 1891, reverting to the status of a town council in 1974. From 1965, the figures include Linslade (formerly Bucks). Part of the parish of Billington was transferred to Leighton-Linslade in 2003.



LEIGHTON BUZZARD – see also the chapelries (Billington, Eggington, Heath & Reach and Stanbridge) for which separate figures are given from 1801. If the population of the whole parish is required these must be added to those for the Township or Urban District. Part of the parish of Billington was transferred to Leighton-Linslade in 2003.

LIMBURY – formerly a hamlet in Luton. Became a parish in 1895, but transferred to Luton Borough in 1928

LUTON – the figures for civil parish to 1891 includes the township of Luton and the hamlets of East and West Hyde, Leagrave, Limbury and Stopsley. East and West Hyde were conjoined as the parish of Hyde in 1895. Leagrave, Limbury and part of Stopsley were absorbed in Luton Borough in 1928, and the remainder of Stopsley followed in 1933

MELCHBOURNE – joined with Yelden c.1934, and combined population figures for Melchbourne and Yelden given from 1951

MEPPERSHALL – a small portion of the parish in Hertfordshire was transferred to Bedfordshire by the operation of the 1844 act

MEPPERSHALL – figure for 1831 (444) incorrect owing to an erroneous return

MILTON BRYAN – the figures for 1991 also include Battlesden and Potsgrove

NORTHILL – part of Northill transferred to Sandy U.D.C. in 1933

PODINGTON – population for Farndish included with Podington from 1891

POTSGROVE – the figures from 1991 are included with Milton Bryan

RIDGMONT – figures from 1991 exclude Brogborough

SALFORD – parish amalgamated with Hulcote in 1933 and subsequent population figures given for Hulcote and Salford (q.v.)

SANDY – part of Northill transferred to Sandy U.D.C. in 1933

SHELTON – combined population figures given for Dean and Shelton from 1951

SHILLINGTON – part of Shillington transferred with Holwell to Hertfordshire in 1897. Parts of Shillington and Offley (Herts) exchanged in 1907.

From 1951 to 1981 the figures include Shillington and Lower Stondon. Figures for Shillington include Higham Gobion from 1991, but Lower Stondon (formerly included in Shillington) is now excluded with Upper Stondon

SHILLINGTON – the population figure for Shillington alone in 1981 was 1680

SLIP END – parish created from Caddington in 2001, hence the drop in Caddington's population

SOULDROP – joined with Knotting c.1934, and combined population figures given for Knotting and Souldrop

SOULDROP – the increase in population in 1841 was almost entirely due to the annual feast being in progress at the time of the census (*ex.inf.VCH*)

STAPLOE – parish created from the rural parts of Eaton Socon in 1965 when the rest of the parish was transferred to Huntingdonshire

STEVIINGTON – the increase in population in 1871 (735) was almost entirely due to the presence of labourers employed on railway construction

STEWARTBY – parish created out of Wootton in 1937

STONDON – from 1991, the figures include Upper Stondon and Lower Stondon, those for the latter having previously been included with Shillington from 1951 to 1981

STONDON, Upper – the combined figure for Upper and Lower Stondon in 1981 was 1450

STOPSLEY – formerly a hamlet in Luton. Became a separate parish in 1895, but it was transferred to the Borough of Luton (part in 1928 and part in 1933)

STOTFOLD – the population figures from 1991 include Astwick (estimated population 30)

STREATLEY – part of parish taken into Luton in 1964

STUDHAM – from 1801 to 1891 Studham was partly in Hertfordshire and partly in Bedfordshire. Humbershoe, partly in Studham, was transferred to Hertfordshire in 1897 when the Hertfordshire part of Studham was transferred to Bedfordshire

SUNDON – part of parish taken into Luton in 1964

SWINESHEAD – transferred from Huntingdonshire to Bedfordshire in 1896

TILBROOK – transferred from Bedfordshire to Huntingdonshire in 1896

WOOTTON – the new parish of Stewartby was formed out of Wootton in 1937

WRESTLINGWORTH – the population figures for Cockayne Hatley are included with Wrestlingworth from 1991

WYBOSTON, CHAWSTON & COLESDEN – parish created from Roxton in 2007

YELDEN – joined with Melchbourne c.1934, and combined population figures for Melchbourne and Yelden given from 1951
