Also they say that they give to the Lord for Head Silver as common fine from his residents once a year on Lete Day, from each head of family group jd [1d] and from each heads of tithing another jd [1d], from the sons of permanent residents living [away?] for one year and a day or more jd [1d]. Which totals on this day ijs jd [2s 1d]

Land Silver vs viijd [5s 8d] paid at [illegible]

And that they gave to the Lord on this Lete day once in the year for Land Silver, for [illegible] a head, that is to say vs viijd [5s 8d]
