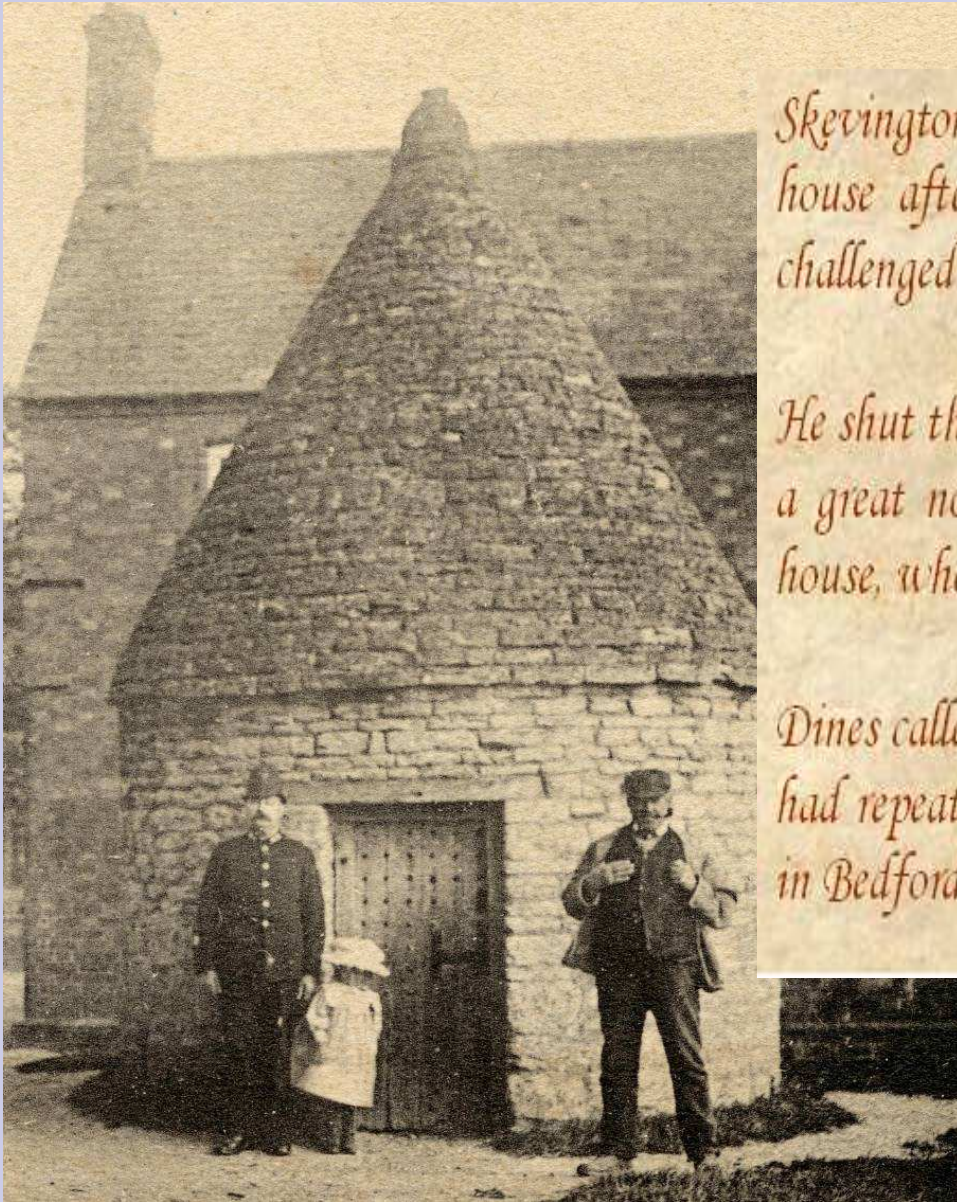


At 2.15pm, Sunday, 9th May, [REDACTED], as the result of a telephone call at Wilstead Police Station, I went to the site of Elstow Abbey, where I contacted [REDACTED], an amateur archaeologist, who was excavating the site near the Abbey for the examination of the ground plan and development of Elstow Nunnery.

He showed to me several trenches he had dug and lying in one of these was a skeleton. It was approximately 5½ feet below ground level and was lying in an East - West position across the trench. It was lying on its back with the arms by its side and the complete skeleton from the mid thighs upwards was revealed.

Skevington Eyles: on Thursday 24 May Charles Dines came to his house after 10pm and charged him with being an informant and challenged him to a fight.

He shut the door. Dines forcibly threw the door open 3 times and made a great noise which collected a great crowd of persons around the house, who then remained there making a disturbance.

Dines called him an informer, thief and every kind of bad name. Dines had repeated this several times in public places since and particularly in Bedford Market.

At that time a hurdle race was being run and the horses were coming in at the winning post. Dr Witt was in his carriage and a lady with him. Dr Witt stood up to see the horses come in. I saw the prisoner get on the hind wheel of the carriage on the hub, but did not take particular notice of him until the lady rose to look at the horses, when the prisoner mounted the tire of the wheel, placed his left hand on the back part of the carriage between the lead and the seat, and stretched himself across the seat and took up the lady's black bag.
