Therefore he incurs the penalty of vjd [6d] from the last court... And he was ordered to put it right in xv [15] days under the <sup>same</sup> penalty. Also they present that (illegible) ditch was on the Kings Road just as he was ordered. And the aforesaid Thomas, [illegible] just as he was ordered at the last view etc.
